This flow chart is formatted to display a "cluster" of courses available to a student during a year. Do not feel obligated to take courses in the *exact* order listed, however, you must meet prerequisites before enrolling in courses.

A minimum of **180** units is required to receive a B.S. in Economics. The Economics flow chart is based on a 24-unit concentration, which may be from the Economics, Business, Political Science, or Social Science departments. Concentration courses cannot be double counted with Major or Support courses. At least 12 units of GE courses must be 300/400 level. \*Either the Physical Science (B3) or Life Science (B2) must have a lab. Econ 303, 304, 322 do not count as a D5. Note regarding electives: Students may use free electives for a minor(s) or an additional concentration(s). \*\*With this sample flow chart you will be one unit short of sophomore.
