

Econ Major Tips

- ❖ The intermediate microeconomics series (Econ 310, 311, 312) and the macroeconomics series (Econ 313, 314) should be taken as early as possible, preferably your Junior year. Pay attention to the course offering schedule, which can be picked up at the Econ department, as these classes are only offered certain quarters.
- ❖ Econ 313 can be taken concurrently with either Econ 311 or 312.
- ❖ Econ 314 should be taken in the first quarter of your senior year.
- ❖ Econ students are encouraged to take an independent Senior Project with an Econ professor. If you should decide to fulfill your Senior Project requirement within your concentration, it must have some link to Economics.
- ❖ Many Econ graduates later wish they had taken more math classes while attending Cal Poly, especially students continuing on to grad school. Recommended additional math courses include:
 - Math 206 (Linear Algebra)
 - Math 141 (which can be substituted for Math 221), 142, and 143 (Intermediate Calculus)
 - Stat 330 and 530.
