MATH 221	ELM requirement and passing score on MAPE, or MATH 118, or equivalent.
STAT 251	Completion of ELM requirement and a passing score on MAPE for MATH 221, or MATH 118 or equivalent. Please note: You may take Stat 251 before taking Math 221 as long as you are eligible to take Math 221.
STAT 252	STAT 251 with a minimum grade of C-.

BUS 207	Sophomore standing.
BUS 214	Sophomore standing.
BUS 215	Demonstrated competency in electronic spreadsheet, word processing, and presentation applications, BUS 212 or BUS 214 or equivalent.
BUS 342	A grade of C- or better in all of the following: ECON 222, MATH 221, STAT 252, BUS 215. Junior standing required.
BUS 346	A grade of C- or better in all of the following: ECON 222, STAT 252, BUS 207, junior standing, or equivalent.
IT 371	A grade of C- or better in all of the following: MATH 141 or MATH 221, and STAT 211 or STAT 252, and junior standing.
BUS 387	Junior standing. Recommended: A grade of C- or better in STAT 252.
BUS 391	Junior standing or consent of instructor.
BUS 401	A grade of C- or better in all 300-level business core courses (BUS 342, BUS 346, IT 371, BUS 387, and BUS 391) and senior standing.
