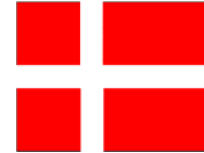




Denmark



Following are some of the opportunities available to you in Denmark:

OCOB exchange with Copenhagen Business School (CBS)

Language requirement: none; taking the one week Danish crash course is recommended

Cost: students pay regular Cal Poly fees and expenses; airfare/visa/health insurance/accommodations; no separate "program cost"

Accommodations: private room; house/flat; residence hall; assistance provided from CBS

Courses students have successfully substituted at CBS: BUS 215, BUS 302, BUS 342, BUS 346, BUS 387, BUS 391, BUS 402, ECON 304, ECON 322, ECON 405, GE C4

Timeframe: semester system (one or two semesters); summer program available

Notes: can be competitive as exchange numbers are limited; students must apply for an exchange spot from the OCOB and then be recommended to CBS

Denmark International Studies (DIS)

Language requirement: none

Cost: \$8525 (one semester); \$14,920 (academic year); \$1180-\$2065 mandatory insurance; airfare/visa/accommodations

Accommodations: family stay; residence hall; house/flat; assistance provided from DIS

Courses students have successfully substituted at DIS: BUS 384, BUS 402, BUS 404, BUS 407, BUS 446, Senior Project, BUS 470, ECON 304, ECON 405, ECON 431, GE C1, GE C4

Timeframe: semester system; summer program available

Notes: scholarships are available through DIS; study tours in European cities are included in your fee; additional tours available; many students have a 30-60 minute commute to school
