Refer to online catalog for GE course selection, United States Cultural Pluralism (USCP) and Graduation Writing Requirement (GWR). USCP requirement can be satisfied by some (but not all) courses within GE categories: C3, C4, D1, D3, D4, D5 or F.

<sup>1</sup> Students pursuing the Quantitative concentration should take STAT 301 and 302 instead of STAT 251 and 252. If STAT 301 and 302 are taken, 4 units of GE B1 are needed to meet the GE B1 requirement

<sup>2</sup> Students pursuing the Quantitative concentration should take MATH 141 and 142 instead of just MATH 141.

<sup>3</sup> Students pursuing General Economics may double count C4, D5, F for "Any 300-400" level class. Double counting will cause an increase in number of free electives needed.

<sup>4</sup> Economics majors do not need a to choose a concentration but they can if they choose. Students who choose not to declare a concentration must fulfill the requirements of General Economics: Complete at least 8 units 300-400 level ECON coursework plus any 20 units of coursework at 300-400 level.

<sup>5</sup>Unit value will be determined by concentration selected.
